



### **Community Classroom Parent/Caregiver Information**

1. Support from teachers in a Community Classroom is a service the Southern Health School provides subject to the conditions below. It is not a “right.” We will immediately withdraw services if these conditions are not met.
2. All sessions and visits to SHS Community Classrooms are by appointment. If circumstances change and the student is no longer able to attend, the parent/caregiver must notify the teacher before the planned session.
3. Arrangements for drop off and pick up of the student need to be agreed between the parent and teacher prior to the first Community Classroom based teaching session. While students are travelling to and from SHS Community Classroom they are the responsibility of their caregiver. Prompt collection of students from the Community Classroom is required at the end of each session.
4. The student is required to bring all required books and equipment, be prepared for the lesson and be dressed appropriately for school.
5. Arrangements for breaks from learning will be arranged with the teacher.
6. If the student’s behaviour or health condition gives cause for concern the teacher will contact the parent/caregiver immediately. If the behaviour does not improve the teacher will make arrangements with the parent/caregiver for the student to be collected.
7. While we endeavour to offer the Community Classroom Service, various factors may affect its continuation. If this should occur other options will be made available to the student.
